A record must be disclosed to a requester unless it falls within one of the specific exemptions or exclusions outlined in FIPPA in which case parts of a record or a record in its entirety will be withheld.

Personal Information and Privacy

In the course of HHHS' operations we collect personal information from and about individuals. This information covers a wide range of subjects and is used to administer programs and activities. The majority of personal information maintained by HHHS is classified as personal health information which is subject to different legislation entitled the *Personal Health Information Protection Act*, 2004 (PHIPA). FIPPA gives individuals a right of access to their personal health information subject to certain specific exemptions. At the same time, FIPPA safeguards an individual's privacy by protecting this information from unauthorized disclosure to others.
