

INTEREST POSTING – EPIC SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS

Seeking RN or RPN's with ER/Acute Experience to immediately join our HHHS EPIC Team as Subject Matter Expert

Background:

HHHS will be going live with the Epic Clinical Information System this fall. This will transform healthcare in our region and enhance the patient and provider experience.

A Subject Matter Expert (SME) is an expert in our Emergency and/or Acute areas. As a SME, you will be one of HHHS's most valuable assets during the build, testing, training, and at go-live. You will combine knowledge of the new system with your knowledge of past workflows and practices in order to make sure EPIC works seamlessly for HHHS.

Required Immediately: 1 Full Time or 2 Part Time RN or RPN

Clinical Team members are required immediately for a minimum of 2 days per week to join the active HHHS implementation team to;

- provide expertise in current state practice and help map to future state workflows
- end to end testing
- preparing for training
- support at Go-live and beyond

Time Commitment and Expectations:

This position is a temporary full-time commitment (April – December 2021) but consideration will also be given to hiring 2 temporary part-time staff willing to dedicate a minimum of 2 days per week to this project. Full-time and part-time staff are welcome to apply.

• After the go-live date, the SME will return to their permanent HHHS position/ schedule.

• The ability to grant time off work will be subject to the requirements of the project.

Other Important Information:

- All employees that are selected to be a SME will maintain their current classification and compensation rate
- Compensation for hours of work will be in accordance with your current collective agreement (if unionized) or in accordance with HHHS policies (if non-unionized)
