Reporting to the HHHS EPIC Site Lead, the Epic at the Elbow (ATE) Specialist plays an integral role in supporting HHHS staff and physicians during the implementation of the EPIC Clinical Information System (CIS).

You will be deployed primarily within clinical patient areas to support physicians and other clinical team members at go-live. Confidentiality and professionalism is a must.

To prepare you for this role you will receive detailed training on Epic and will assist with classroom training delivery to both physicians and nursing staff to perfect your skills.

The goal of the At the Elbow (ATE) Specialist is to provide on-unit support such that staff effectively and efficiently utilize the CIS during the first few critical transition weeks at go-live on Dec 3rd.
