Nestled in the heart of cottage country, just 2 ½ hours north east of Toronto in the Haliburton Highlands, Haliburton Highlands Health Services (HHHS) delivers high-quality health services to residents, cottagers, and visitors to Haliburton County and the surrounding area. We strive to be leaders in innovative rural health care, and we work closely with local and regional partners to promote wellness and provide access to essential health services, including Primary Care, Hospital (Acute Inpatient and Emergency Care), Long-Term Care, End-of-Life Care, Mental Health & Addictions Services, and Community Support Services.

Minden and Haliburton hospital sites are part of HHHS. Each site operates an emergency department with over 35,000 combined visits per year. The Haliburton site also has a 15-bed Acute Care in-patient unit with two Palliative Care beds. Nursing staff work at both locations in all three departments, based on qualifications, experience, and staffing requirements. Rural nursing at these locations offers professionals the opportunity to use a wide variety of skills in a friendly, person-centred care environment.

Hyland Crest, a 62-bed facility located at the Minden site, and Highland Wood, a 30-bed facility at the Haliburton site, are Long Term Care facilities providing RN, RPN, and PSW services to the residents. Guided by the Ministry of Health & Long Term Care standards, the two nursing homes provide optimal care to the community's elderly folk. Daily activities, nutritional meals, planned outings and visiting entertainers help to ensure well-rounded events for those who choose to participate.

Corporate Culture:

At Haliburton Highlands Health Services, we are anchored by our vision, mission and values and guided by our strategic plan.
