Position Scope:

The Clinical Extern is an unregulated health care provider working under the supervision of registered health care professionals. They will work within a changing environment in interprofessional teams to advocate for and promote wellness while ensuring the delivery of safe, quality care. The Clinical Extern will develop their competencies through learning, education, experience and reflective practice. As part of our ongoing commitment to professional growth and development, Clinical Externs may be considered for future opportunities upon graduation and licensure.

Renefits:

A permanent, full-time position includes a benefit plan, life/accident insurance, paid vacation and sick days, STD and LTD plans, a Pension Plan (HOOPP), EAP and access to HHHS Perkopolis discounts. The Haliburton County Area has qualified for the Government of Canada's partial Student Loan forgiveness program for eligible nurses who practice in under-served communities. Casual and part-time positions will include a % of vacation pay and a % of pay in lieu of benefits as well as access to EAP and Perkopolis discounts.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Must be a Nursing Student between 2nd and 4th year of a College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO) approved
 Baccalaureate Nursing (BScN or BN) program, or in final year of a Practical Nursing (PN) program or a
 Respiratory Therapy Student in 2nd or 3rd year of training program accredited by the Council on Accreditation
 of Respiratory Therapy Education, administered by the Canadian Society of Respiratory Therapists
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to interact well with all levels of staff and the community.
- Excellent issues management and relationship building skills.
- Ability to adapt to continually changing priorities.
- Demonstrated ability to work in a fast-paced environment with multiple demands at a time.
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and use good judgement, and as a team member.
