Screeners provide a number of questions that are related to potential COVID symptoms, recent travel and contact with others, to visitors and staff. If questions are answered in a positive manner, they are denied entry and sent home or recommended to go to ER for assessment.

- Demonstrated working knowledge of spoken and written English
- Experience working in a health care setting or security, related social service, or educational field (may include high school health co-op or volunteer work in a health or long-term care setting) is an asset
