POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Manager, Life Enrichment, provides supervision to the Activity Aides, ensuring compliance with regulatory and organizational standards, while maintaining effective and efficient operations of both homes. This position is responsible for the development and implementation of meaningful recreational and social activities for residents who have physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual limitations. They liaise and support with both resident and family councils.

QUALIFICATIONS:

To achieve this, the successful candidate must possess:

- A post-secondary diploma or degree in recreation and leisure studies, therapeutic recreation, kinesiology or other related field from a community college or university
- At least 2 year of experience within a long term care environment
- Minimum 2 years' supervisory or management experience, preferably in an Activity Department in long-term care
- Additional Training: Montessori, GPA, Palliative Care
- Experience in assessing activation needs, development, implementation and evaluation of activation programs
- Experience in the recruitment, selection, orientation, placement and supervision of volunteers.
- Experience working in a unionized environment
- Experience working within a palliative care philosophy
