The Opportunity

HHHS has a great opportunity for an Emergency Medicine Physician to provide patient care to a wonderful and appreciative community at the Haliburton site. The Emergency Department is averages 15,000 visits per year, and has excellent in-house and referral centre support. The successful applicant must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario with CCFP (EM) certification or CCFP with experience is preferred. In addition, the candidate must have ACLS and ATLS certification, and PALS is an asset. Emphasis will be placed on candidates with strong communication skills and experience working in rural environments. Family Medicine positions are also available within the community.

Incentives & Compensation

- ER Physicians are paid under the AFA (Alternate Funding Agreement).
- Haliburton County Physician Recruitment Program offers a return of service incentive of \$25,000 per year for a minimum of 4 years and up to a maximum of 6 years, for a total of \$150,000, for physicians moving to the area to practice Family Medicine, Emergency Medicine, or both.
- The Ministry of Health also has a 4 year ROS available for each of the municipalities in our County; \$92,160 payable over four years.
- Physicians also qualify for \$40,000 of OSAP Loan Forgiveness while practicing in our County.
