2025-2026

This year, the HHHS Foundation is focused on raising funds for immediate needs in the hospital and long-term care homes and subsidies for community support services. Specific needs include emergency department equipment like a Portable ECG and Vital Signs Machine with pediatric tools, equipment for the new gynecology and internal medicine clinics, education assistance for staff advancement at HHHS, and subsidies for seniors-in-need living in the county.

There are so many things that make Haliburton County special – the beautiful environment, the vibrant arts community, recreational activities to be enjoyed year-round. But above all, it's the people that make this a special place, people who care, people like you.
